

MEASUREMENTS FOR DOGS

Unless otherwise stated, pull the measuring tape snug – but not too tight – and don't add extra ease.

- Neck circumference (e.g. for collar with buckle, bandana, Infinity scarf)

 2 fingers should fit between the neck and the tape measure.
- Neck circumference, slimmest (e.g. for slip collar)
 Usually directly behind the ears.
- Head circumference (e.g. for slip collar, sweater, infinity scarf)

 Broadest, usually directly in front of the ears.
- Neck length (e.g. for infinity scarf, coat collar, hood)
- Circumference neck/back (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness)
- Chest and shoulders front (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness)

 For Norwegian harness measure around up to the intersections with H.
- Chest width (e.g. for chest/belly protection, harness)

 Between the front legs
- Length of chest and belly protection (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness)
- Fotal length (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat)
- G Height (at withers) up to 40 cm [15"] = small / up to 60 cm [23"] = medium / up to 70 cm [27"] = large / above 70 cm [27"] = giant
- Chest/belly circumference (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness)

 Distance from front legs: 6 cm [2.4"] small, 10 cm [4"] medium, 15 cm [6"] large dogs
- Length at withers (e.g. for Norwegian harness)
 Across the back up to the intersection of D1 and H
- Back length (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat)
 from C to the tail or to your desired length for a coat
- Waist circumference (e.g. for sweater, bath robe, coat, harness, belly band, panties)
